

Leonardo is fighting a life-threatening cancer

Leonardo is a four-year-old from London who loves superheroes and motorcycles.

In May 2022, Leonardo was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma and sadly towards the end of frontline treatment scans showed new areas of disease.

As relapsed neuroblastoma is particularly challenging to treat, Leonardo's family are fundraising for potentially lifesaving treatment that is currently not available through the NHS that they hope will get him back into remission.

Funds raised will go towards helping Leonardo and his family. If Leonardo no longer needs the funds or is in remission five years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through Solving Kids' Cancer UK's activities. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Leonardo, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Upon relapse, this rate reduces even further.
